

Car – Cost sharing

Preamble: It is expected that passengers and drivers contribute to marginal vehicle-running costs when travelling to ski resorts and related accommodation. Marginal costs include fuel, servicing, fluids, etc, but exclude capital costs, depreciation, registration and insurance. *From June 2011, the Club recommends the following cost-share guidelines.*

The table below has individual cost-shares (in \$) for various destinations, with cars being grouped by size, thus approximate running cost (c/km), and number of persons on board.

Classified in columns **A**: Less than 1950 cc, eg. Astra, Echo, Laser 18 c/km.

Classified in columns **B**: Subaru, Commodore, Falcon, small 4WD 24 c/km.

Classified in columns **C**: Large 4WD, eg. Land Cruiser, Patrol, Pajero 34 c/km.

In addition, all occupants should pay a share of the day-entry fee to the resort - whether or not a season ticket is owned - plus, if required, a share of the hire of snow-chains.
